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Re: Commitment regarding GHG CleanStart™ Registry

Our commitment is as follows:

1. CSA Group will compile its **Corporate Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Inventory** for North American operations covering fiscal year April 1, 2006, March 31, 2007. The GHG inventory will cover all buildings, all employee air travel, all inspectors and auditors' car travel and all of CSA Group's vehicle fleet;
2. A **Corporate GHG Report** will be drafted. It will follow the requirements and guidance provided in the ISO 14064-1 standard. The Corporate GHG Report will be submitted for posting on the Registry;
3. The Corporate GHG Report and relevant documentation will be verified by an independent third party according to the ISO 14064-3 standard. The **Verification Report** will be submitted for posting on the Registry;
4. Greenhouse gas emissions from CSA Group North American operations covering facilities and activities listed above will be offset through the purchase of verified emissions reductions, thereby achieving carbon neutrality status. A **Carbon Neutral Report** will be submitted for posting on the Registry;
5. Results from the GHG inventory will be analyzed by senior management. **Directed Actions** and investments will be made to reduce CSA Group's GHG emissions in future years;
6. This commitment is made by the President & CEO of CSA Group.
