

Re: Commitment to GHG CleanStart™ Registry

This letter will confirm that Wakefield Canada Inc's commitment is as follows:

1. Wakefield Canada Inc (Wakefield) has compiled its **Corporate Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Inventory** for it's operations covering the 2008 calendar year from January 1 to December 31, 2008. The GHG inventory covers energy usage in it's buildings, truck fleet, car fleet, employee air travel and propane vehicles.
2. **Wakefield's 2008 Corporate GHG Report** has been drafted and follows the requirements and guidance provided in the ISO 14064-1 standard. This report will be submitted for posting on the Registry.
3. The Corporate GHG Report and relevant documentation will be verified by an independent third party according to the ISO 14064-3 standard. The **Verification Report** will be submitted for posting on the Registry.
4. Greenhouse gas emissions from Wakefield will be offset through the purchase of verified emissions reductions, thereby achieving carbon neutrality status. A **Carbon Neutral Report** will be submitted for posting on the Registry.
5. Results from the GHG inventory will be analyzed by senior management. **Directed Actions** and investments will be made to reduce Wakefield's GHG emissions in future years.
6. Wakefield is committed to following the aforementioned process for the calendar year 2009.
7. This commitment is made by the Chief Operating Officer of Wakefield Canada Inc.
